Queensland's Regional NRM Bodies Outputs 2008-09

In the 12 months to 30 June 2009, Queensland's Regional NRM Organisations:

- Protected **376,291** hectares of native vegetation with fencing
- Rehabilitated or enhanced **446,448** hectares of vegetation
- Revegetated **1054** hectares of native vegetation
- Controlled pest plants over **227,619** hectares
- Controlled pest animals over **776,390** hectares
- Engaged **137** land managers who collectively improved irrigation practices over **6,378** hectares of land
- Undertook **552** new or improved natural resource monitoring programs
- Protected **463** conservation agreements
- Undertook **5,348** biophysical studies or surveys
- Developed **2,226** sub-regional plans
- Delivered **1,597** awareness raising events, for **87,857** people
- Delivered **1,279** training events, for **13,889** participants
- Assisted **5,723** community groups or projects
- Developed **2,323** collaborative arrangements
