

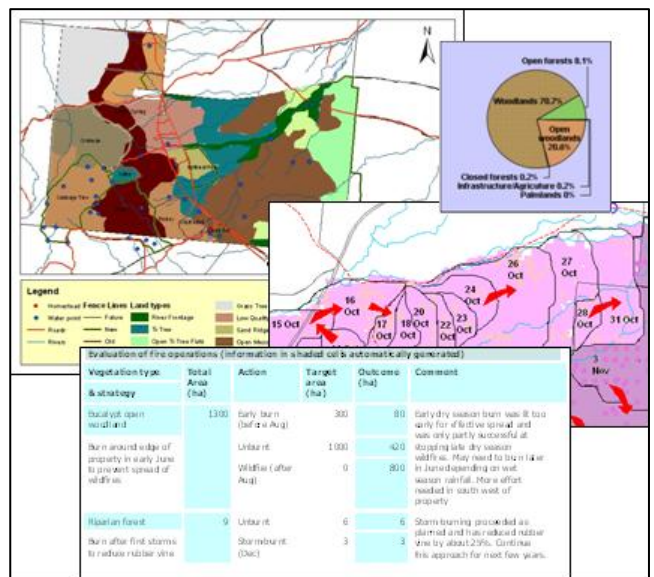


**Grazing Infonet** will provide pastoralists with the latest information, resources and advice for planning pastoral operations on their own property using a web-map delivery system developed for the Infonet platform ([www.infonet.org.au](http://www.infonet.org.au)).

**Grazing Infonet** will enhance Grazing Land Management (GLM) programs by:

- giving pastoralists an idea of what GLM is about, and encouraging them to attend GLM activities
- providing follow-up support and resources for people who have attended more formal GLM activities
- letting people who might never get to a GLM workshop understand and adopt best practice pastoral management

Tropical Savannas CRC is currently developing a Northern Territory **Grazing Infonet** in collaboration the Northern Territory Government, NT NRM Board and the pastoral industry. It is hoped that a Queensland **Grazing Infonet** will also be developed in collaboration with the Queensland pastoral industry, regional NRM groups and government agencies.



The **Grazing Infonet** team will work with the pastoral industry and onground GLM teams to develop a user-driven product that meets pastoralists' needs for planning information. For example, Queensland **Grazing Infonet** could, free of charge, provide pastoralists with access to:

- existing maps layers that characterise their property's pastoral values (e.g. land system maps), hazards (e.g. salinity, fire & weeds) and conservation values (e.g. vegetation maps & species lists)
- existing recommended & regionally appropriate pastoral management practices (e.g. stocking rates, spelling routines, fire management, weed management) and conservation management options (e.g. water point placement, conservation agreements, carbon offsets)
- other planning information (e.g. lease renewal conditions, OnePlan, duty of care principles)
- summaries of (and links to) other NRM resources

The **Northern Territory Grazing Infonet** will generate property-specific booklets that will describe:

- the character of the property (e.g. location, size, climate, land systems, weeds, conservation values)
- recommended & regionally appropriate grazing practices at the property-scale
- options for conservation management
- how to develop a property plan
