## Towards 2015: Developing a Strategic Investment Plan for sustainable agriculture in Queensland

During the second half of 2007, industry, natural resource management and government organisations are collaborating to scope a strategic investment plan for sustainable agriculture in Queensland.

This project builds on existing activities already being implemented by industry and primary producers.

The aim is to better coordinate and position Queensland's agriculture to better address current key issues.

The vision for sustainable agriculture in Queensland is to build:

- Healthy natural systems, and
- Resilient agriculture industries

The strategic investment plan will be delivered through effective partnerships which explore the links between natural systems and agricultural systems.





## Have your say

A strategic investment plan addressing the identified priority issues is being developed to influence future funding opportunities.

Queensland's regional NRM bodies, peak agricultural industry groups, government agencies and on-ground land managers are encouraged to have a say on strategic issues and perspectives to collaboratively develop this joint investment plan for Queensland.

Times and places for consultation on the investment plan are scheduled from October to mid-November 2007. The investment plan will be finalised in January 2008.
